****Past to Present Descriptions (I will explain more in our next class)****

- In the picture = present tense
- In the map = present tense
- At the top of the illustration = present tense
- At the bottom of the picture = present tense
- In the depiction = present tense
- 1. In the picture, there are many housing units in the northwest.
- 2. In the town, there were many housing units in the northwest.

"I can see in the picture that there were many people at your graduation"

"The designers will be constructing a large cafe beside the enhanced entrance near the ATM machines."

Future Tenses

Future Perfect Active:

Subject + will have + Verb 3 + Object

"The designers will have built a modern ICT room in the east of the library."

Future Perfect Passive:

Subject + will have been + Verb 3 + Object

"In the east of the library, a modern ICT room will have been built."

Future Perfect Passive + by + noun:

Subject + will have been + Verb 3 + Object + by + Noun

"In the east of the library, a modern ICT room will have been built by architects."
