## 30+ Sentence Patterns for IELTS Writing Task 2

### 1. Introduction:

- In recent years, + Noun + has become a subject of increasing importance.
- The issue of + Noun + has drawn significant attention in + Noun.
- This essay seeks to discuss/analyze/examine the benefits of + Noun.
- The purpose of this essay is to critically evaluate/discuss the solutions to + Noun.
- It is widely acknowledged that + Noun + is a complex and multifaceted phenomenon.

#### Example:

*In recent years, New Zealand's education has become a subject of increasing importance.*

### 2. Thesis Statement:

- This essay argues that + Relative Clause.
- The central theme of this essay is to demonstrate that + Relative Clause.
- The focus of this essay is to highlight the significance of + Noun Phrase.

#### Example:

*This essay argues that education is crucial for society.*

### 3. Background Information:

- To understand + Noun + better, it is essential to provide some historical context.
- Noun + has a long and rich history, dating back to + Noun.
- Various factors have contributed to the emergence/growth of + Noun.

#### Example:

*To understand online education better, it is essential to provide some historical context.*

### 4. Significance and Relevance:

- Noun + is of utmost importance because of its implications for + Noun.
- Understanding + Noun + is crucial to address pressing issues such as + Noun.
- The relevance of + Noun + extends beyond + Noun + to impact + Noun.

#### Example:

*Education is of utmost importance because of its implications for social welfare.*

## 30+ Sentence Patterns for IELTS Writing Task 2

### 5. Definition:

- Noun + can be defined as + Noun Phrase.
- In simple terms, + Noun + refers to + Noun.
- Scholars have defined + Noun + in various ways, but it generally encompasses + Noun.

#### Example:

*Education can be defined as the ongoing development of an individual.*

### 6. Advantages and Disadvantages:

- Noun + offers several advantages, including + List of Nouns.
- However, it is essential to consider the drawbacks, such as + List of Nouns.

#### Example:

*Education offers several advantages, including critical thinking, communication, creativity, and collaboration skills.*

### 7. Causes and Effects:

- The causes of + Noun + are multifaceted, ranging from + Noun + to + Noun.
- The effects of + Noun + can be observed in + Noun + and + Noun.

#### Example:

*The effects of low school grades can be observed in the community and in professional settings.*

- The controversy surrounding + Noun + revolves around + List of Nouns.

#### Example:

*Education has sparked intense debates, with proponents arguing that education should be free, and opponents asserting that students should pay to learn.*

### 10. Evaluating Evidence:

- The available evidence suggests that + Relative Clause.
- However, there are counterarguments that challenge this evidence, such as + List of Nouns.

#### Example:

*The available evidence suggests that education is vital to social development.*

### 11. Proposed Solutions:

- To address + Noun Phrase, + several potential solutions have been proposed, including + Noun + and + Noun.
- Each solution has its merits and limitations, requiring careful consideration.

#### Example:

*To address low grades in school, several potential solutions have been proposed, including employing more teachers, increasing class instructional time, and encouraging more group work.*

### 12. Future Implications:

- The future implications of + Noun + are uncertain, but + Pronoun + may lead to + Noun.
- Addressing + Noun + proactively is crucial to mitigate its future impact on + Noun.

### 13. Conclusion:

- In conclusion, this essay has demonstrated that + Relative Clause.
- To conclude, + S + V + O.
- The evidence presented in this essay supports the idea that + Relative Clause.

### Example:

*In conclusion, this essay has demonstrated that education plays a developmental role in the improvement of local and national communities.*

## Typical Essay Format

### Introduction

- Background information
- Thesis Statement/answer question
- Intentions

### Body Paragraph One

- Topic sentence
- Example and explanation
- Mini-conclusion

### Body Paragraph Two

- Topic sentence
- Example and explanation
- Mini-conclusion

### Body Paragraph Three\*

- Give your opinion and a brief reason

### Conclusion

- Rephrase thesis statement
- Link topic sentences and mini-conclusions to introduction
- Repeat answer(s)

**\*Body Paragraph Three is not required if the question does not directly ask: "...and give your opinion"**

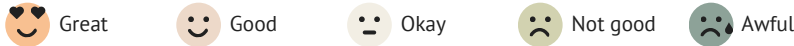

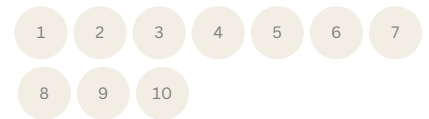
