Question Words:

- What is your favourite food?
- Where is your hometown?
- Who do you live with?
- When do you travel to work?
- How often do eat your favourite food?
- How do you go to work?
- Do/Does you like international music? (Yes/No)
- What kind/kinds/types/sorts of clothes do you wear? (2 Examples)

Answer: e.g., My favourite food is Thai food, but I also like Japanese food. Describe:

Strategy/Technique:

- Answer: Use the same vocabulary, tense, tense form, from the question
- **Describe**: Proper Nouns/Nouns


2 Strategies Answer -> Describe
