- Artistic Expression - The manifestation of one's creativity and imagination through various forms of art (การแสดงอารมณ์ทางศิลปะ)
 - Audience - The group of people who attend a performance, show, or event (ผู้ชม)
 - Abstract Art - Art that does not attempt to represent an accurate depiction of visual reality but instead uses shapes, colors, forms, and gestural marks to achieve its effect (ศิลปะนามธรรม)
 - Avant-garde - Innovative and experimental works in the arts, often pushing the boundaries of traditional practices (อะวีองการ์ด)
 - Biopic - A biographical film that dramatizes the life of a real person (บิโอพิก)
 - Ballet - A form of dance characterized by grace and precision of movement (บัลเล่ต์)
 - Broadway - The theater district in New York City, synonymous with American theater and musical productions (บรอดเวย์)
 - Cinema - The art and industry of making movies; also, a place where films are shown (ภาพยนตร์)
 - Comedy - A genre of entertainment that aims to amuse and entertain through humor (คอมเมดี้)
 - Concert - A live music performance in front of an audience (คอนเสิร์ต)

- Contemporary Art - Art produced in the present time that reflects current ideas and perspectives (ศิลปะร่วมสมัย)
 - Crafts - Activities involving the creation of handmade objects, often for decorative or functional purposes (งานฝีมือ)
 - Collage - A technique of composing a work of art by pasting materials such as paper, fabric, and photographs onto a surface (โคลลаж)
 - Dramaturgy - The art or technique of dramatic composition and theatrical representation (ramaทารย์จี)
 - Dance - A series of rhythmic and expressive bodily movements, usually performed to music (เต้น)
 - Drama - A genre of literature, film, or television that focuses on realistic storytelling and emotional intensity (ละคร)
 - Drawing - The act of creating a picture or diagram by making lines and marks on paper or other surfaces (การวาด)
 - Exhibition - A public display of works of art or other items of interest (นิทรรศการ)
 - Exquisite Corpse - A collaborative drawing and writing game in which each participant adds to a composition in sequence, often without seeing the prior portions (เกมทำภาพ หรือซองกลม)
 - Fan Fiction - Fictional stories created by fans of a work of fiction rather than by its creator (นิยายที่แฟนสร้าง)

- Film Festival - An organized event where films are shown and often evaluated by critics and the public (ເທສກາລກາພຍນຕົ້ງ)
- Folk Music - Traditional music passed down through generations within a specific cultural group (ດນຕີເພື່ອນເມືອງ)
- Gallery - A room or building where works of art are displayed for public viewing (ຫອສິລົງ)
- Graffiti - Unauthorized writing or drawings on public walls, often in urban areas (ກຣາຟິຕີ)
- Glassblowing - The art of shaping molten glass into various forms using a blowpipe and other tools (ກາຣທຳແກ້ວ)
- Hyperrealism - A genre of art that resembles high-resolution photography, often emphasizing minute details (ໄຊເປົອຮີແອລລິສົດ)
- Hip Hop - A cultural movement that includes rap music, breakdancing, and graffiti art (ອີປໂອປ)
- Improvisation - The creation of something without preparation or planning, often used in theater and music (ກາຣປັບປຸງ)
- Installation Art - Art that is created for a specific space and often involves the use of various materials and techniques (ສິລປະຕິດຕັ້ງ)
- Juxtaposition - The act or placement of two things (usually abstract concepts, though it can involve physical objects) near each other (ກາຣວາງຂໍາມ)

- Jazz - A genre of music characterized by improvisation, syncopation, and a strong rhythm (แจ๊ส)
- Karaoke - A form of entertainment in which people sing along to recorded music (卡拉โอเกะ)
- Kinetic Art - Art that includes movement, often powered by wind, motors, or other means (ศิลปะที่เคลื่อนไหว)
- Limerick - A humorous poem of five lines, typically with a rhyme scheme of AABBA (ลิเมริก)
- Literature - Written works, especially those considered to have artistic or intellectual value (วรรณกรรม)
- Live Performance - A presentation or show that is experienced in real-time by an audience (การแสดงสด)
- Macramé - The art of knotting cords into a pattern to make decorative items (การปักสายด้วยการผูกปลาย)
- Masterpiece - A work of outstanding artistry, skill, or workmanship (ผลงานคุณภาพ)
- Mural - A large painting or artwork applied directly to a wall or ceiling (ภาพเขียนบนผนัง)
- Musical - A theatrical production that incorporates singing and dancing as essential elements of the storytelling (เวทีเพลง)

- Novelist - A person who writes novels, a practitioner of the art of novel writing (นักเขียนนวนิยาย)
 - Orchestra - A large group of musicians playing various instruments together (วงดนตรี)
 - Painting - The art or practice of applying paint to a surface, creating images or designs (การระบายสี)
 - Performing Arts - Forms of art that are performed in front of an audience, including theater, dance, and music (ศิลปะการแสดง)
 - Photography - The art or practice of taking and processing photographs (การถ่ายภาพ)
 - Playwright - A person who writes plays, scripts for theatrical productions (นักเขียนบทละคร)
 - Poetry - Literary work in which special intensity is given to the expression of feelings and ideas (กวี)
 - Pop Culture - Modern popular culture transmitted via mass media and aimed particularly at younger people (วัฒนธรรมป็อป)
 - Portrait - A painting, drawing, or photograph of a person, typically focusing on the face (ภาพเหมือน)
 - Pottery - The art or craft of making objects out of clay and firing them in a kiln (งานหล่อเลี่ยน)

- Rehearsal - The practice or trial performance of a play, concert, or other work in preparation for public presentation (การซ้อม)
- Rock and Roll - A genre of popular music that originated and evolved in the United States in the late 1940s and early 1950s (ร็อคแอนด์โรล)
- Sculpture - The art of making two- or three-dimensional representative or abstract forms, especially by carving stone or wood or by casting metal (ปั้นจากหิน, โลหะ, หรือไม้)
- Set Design - The creation and arrangement of scenery and props on a stage for a theatrical production (การออกแบบเช็ต)
- Singer-songwriter - A musician who writes, composes, and performs their own music (นักร้องนักแต่งเพลง)
- Sketch - A rough or unfinished drawing or painting, often a preliminary study (ภาพเขียนคร�ย)
- Street Art - Art created in public spaces, often unauthorized, using various techniques such as graffiti and murals (ศิลปะในท้องถนน)
- Symphony - An elaborate musical composition for full orchestra, typically in four movements (ซิมโฟนี)
- Theater - A building or outdoor area in which plays and other dramatic performances are given (โรงละคร)
- Traditional Dance - Dances that are part of a community's cultural heritage and passed down through generations (การเต้นที่เป็นทางการ)

- Unplugged - A style of musical performance featuring acoustic instruments and emphasizing intimate, stripped-down arrangements (การแสดงที่ไม่ใช้ไฟ)
- Variety Show - A form of entertainment featuring various acts, such as music, comedy, and magic (โฉวหลากหลาย)
- Visual Arts - Art forms that create works that are primarily visual in nature, such as painting and sculpture (ศิลปะทางมองเห็น)
- Watercolor - A painting method in which pigments are suspended in a water-based solution (ภาพวาดด้วยสีน้ำ)
- Webcomic - A comic strip or comic book published on the internet (เว็บคอมมิค)
- Writer's Block - The condition of being unable to think of what to write or how to proceed with writing (ปิดกั้นข้อคิดขึ้นในเขียน)
- Xylography - The art of engraving on wood, especially as a method of printing pictures (การแกะสลักไม้)
- Yearning - A strong feeling of intense longing or desire (ความปรารถนา)
- Youth Culture - The lifestyle, values, and interests of young people as a cultural group (วัฒนธรรมของวัยรุ่น)


