PARTS OF SPEECH

Parts of speech are the basic grammatical categories into which words are classified based on their functions and relationships within a sentence. These categories help us understand the roles that words play in conveying meaning. The major parts of speech include:

- Noun: Represents a person, place, thing, or idea. Examples: dog, city, love.
- **Pronoun:** Takes the place of a noun. Examples: he, she, it, they.
- Verb: Describes an action or a state of being. Examples: run, eat, is.
- Adjective: Describes or modifies a noun or pronoun. Examples: happy, red, tall.
- Adverb: Describes or modifies a verb, adjective, or other adverb. Examples: quickly, very, well.
- Preposition: Shows the relationship of a noun or pronoun to another word in the sentence. Examples: in, on, under.
- Conjunction: Connects words, phrases, or clauses. Examples: and, but, or.
- Interjection: Expresses strong emotion or surprise. Examples: Wow!, Ouch!, Hey!
- Article: Defines a noun as specific or unspecific. There are two types: definite (the) and indefinite (a, an). Examples: a cat, the house.

Look at the following examples:

Noun:

New Zealand is known for its stunning landscapes.

Pronoun:

It is an island country in the southwestern Pacific Ocean.

Verb:

The athletes will *compete* in the upcoming sports event in New Zealand.

Adjective:

The **beautiful** beaches of New Zealand attract tourists from around the world.

Adverb:

People drive **slowly** on the scenic roads of New Zealand to enjoy the views.

Preposition:

Many visitors go to New Zealand for adventure and exploration.

Conjunction:

You can visit both the North Island **and** the South Island of New Zealand.

Interjection:

Wow, the landscapes in New Zealand are truly breathtaking!

Article:

The North Island and the South Island are distinct in their geography.
